## Street Class Cruise

Cruise (maximum of 30 points). All cars in King Street, Real Street and True Street classes are required to make four laps around the BIR road course.

- -Headlights and taillights on and signals flashing, stop the engine for five minutes and
- Cars will be evenly spaced and a minimum speed must be maintained.
- Cruise will be Saturday after the day's racing is completed.
- To compete on Sunday, all cars must complete 2 laps of the cruise. Entrants unable to complete 2 laps of the cruise will be allowed to run the ICE or SE classes for the finals.
- If 50% or more of the cruise is completed the car is allowed to race but gets no cruise points.
- Lap 1 & 2 must be completed before the pace car completes lap number 3.
- No pitting or having parts delivered to repair.

## Cruise rain out policy:

- If rain halts a cruise in process points are awarded to those cars still in the cruise.
- If rain halts the cruise from happening all entries receive full cruise points

Note for cruise classes: To compete in these classes on Sunday, cars must complete 2 laps of the cruise. Entrants unable to complete 2 laps will be allowed to run ICE or SE on Sunday.

Listen to the track announcer for call ups and any changes. If you are out of speaker range tune to 105.3 for the drags and 87.9 for the road course on your FM

\*Did you bring a non-registered vehicle? (ATV, Golf Cart, Minibike, Moped, etc.) NHRA does require that a waiver be signed, and a sticker be displayed on the vehicle. The stickers are \$10 per vehicle and can be purchased at the front gate or at racer registration/shirt shack. If you are caught by staff, sticker is \$20

- \*All asphalt camping/parking are paid spots. You will need to purchase a pro-pad parking pass at the front
- \* Power is now \$40/weekend. If you are using electricity without having purchased an electrical ticket at the front gate and are approached by staff power will be \$60.
- \*All tickets for pro-pad, VIP (full service) campsites and power are required to be visible in the front window of the vehicle facing out for security purposes.

- Check birmn.com Racer Info in any of the 3 event series pages
- You cannot enter two drivers in one vehicle in the same classes. You may not switch drivers once eliminations have begun. You must finish eliminations with the vehicle/driver combination you started with.
- Drivers may enter more than one class. However, one vehicle cannot be entered in more than one Fast Seven class (heads up classes).
- Tow vehicles permitted, maximum one tow vehicle per competition vehicle.
- Any competitor listed as a driver car combination in the current year's BIR Bracket Drag Racing Series points program must compete in only heads up classes.
- No Junior Dragsters, Dragsters, Motorcycles, Snowmobiles etc. This is a door car series.
- Use of engine oil containment device is highly recommended
- Series Champions will earn Year End Banquet Admission for 2023

## Rule removal:

- No contingency decals on body.
- No sponsor names/logos or advertising on body of any kind (other than factory badging).

## MCS RAIN OUT POLICY

- \* Gate admission in non-refundable
- \* If rain halts racing during eliminations, any participants still in the race will receive a refund for racer entry in the form of a credit good for 1 year. If racing halts in the middle of a round it is treated as if the round never happened. Points and purse are awarded according to rounds completed.
- \* Outlaw Pro Mod purse will be split evenly between the remaining racers remaining in competition.
- \* Gate admission, parking, electric and other BIR items are non-refundable.

## All cars must meet show criteria as follows:

- · All vehicles must have hoods. \* (Excluding pre-1950 "Street Rod" type using OE style radiator support grill shell.)
- · Full paint, primer only okay if it covers the entire body panel and is "considered the look of the car"
- · No spot primer.
- · The entire interior must have finished appearance. This includes dash, door panels & flooring. No visible pinch welds, if steel floor must be painted or powder coated
- \*\*Class specific rules may override Show Criteria rules. See your specific class for further entry requirements.
